

KINGSTON USBC WBA ANNUAL TOURNAMENT – 2008

Mar. 29 & 30, Apr. 5 & 6

Mid City Lanes

Please read carefully

ENTRANTS:

1. Entry in the tournament will be open to 2007-08 certified members of the Kingston USBC WBA.
2. The tournament will be HANDICAP & SCRATCH. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the entered average and 220.
3. The tournament shall consist of a four women team event, a two women doubles event, a single event and all events. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in team, doubles and singles event. Total pins will decide the winners. Bowlers entering team, doubles and singles will automatically be eligible for the All Events Trophy. The total of nine games bowled shall determine the All Events standings.
4. A bowler may enter three (3) team events. An individual's first team participation will count towards her All Event score. No more than two bowlers on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings.
5. A bowler may enter doubles and singles event one (1) time only. Bowlers entering doubles MUST enter the singles event. Singles event is bowled immediately following the doubles event.
6. Each entrant must have a bowling ball of her own for individual use in the tournament.
7. Open bowling will not be allowed by tournament contestants on lanes scheduled for tournament use two (2) hours prior to the tournament.
8. No **food, beverage or cell phones** will be allowed in the playing area, except for medical emergencies.

ENTRY:

Entries **OPEN – January 14th, 2008 and CLOSE – March 17th, 2008**

(Entries postmarked on the first business day following entry closing date will be accepted.)

ENTRY FEE:

1. Entry fee will be \$20 per bowler, per event for team, doubles and singles. (\$10 lane, \$10 prize)
An optional \$2 fee will make an entrant eligible for All Events cash award.
2. Full fees MUST accompany each entry. (MONEY ORDER, BANK CHECK or PERSONAL CHECK made payable to Kingston USBC WBA - NO CASH). No entry fee will be returned after the prize list has been drafted.

AVERAGE:

1. Entrants shall use their highest KUSBCWBA sanctioned league average as a regular or substitute in the following order:
 - End of the 2006-07 winter season with 21 games or more.
 - End of the 2007 summer season with 21 games or more.
 - 21 games or more as of the closing date for entries.Bowlers not meeting the above criteria will automatically enter with a 220 average in the Scratch division
2. Rule 319a-1, 319a-2, 319a-3, 319d and 319e - will not apply.
3. Averages will be verified by association manager or a designated representative.
4. All bowlers are responsible for the correct reporting of averages.
5. Substitutes must meet the same average requirements as a tournament entrant.

SCHEDULING:

1. Entries will be scheduled according to request, if possible, and in the order received. The lineup will be the same as submitted on the entry form.
2. LANES WILL BE DRAWN BY THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE. Teams who wish to bowl together shall submit entry forms and fees in the same envelope along with a written request.
3. Bowling shall begin promptly in accordance with prearranged schedule.
4. Team event will be bowled on one pair of lanes. Doubles and Singles will interchange. Two sets of Doubles and Singles will be scheduled on each pair of lanes at the discretion of the tournament director.

CHECK IN TIME:

1. Team captains shall check their team in at least ½ hour before the scheduled time to bowl. Doubles partners shall check in at least ½ hour before scheduled time to bowl.
2. All substitutes shall be submitted to the tournament office at least one (1) hour, if possible, before scheduled time.

TARDY ENTRANTS:

1. If a full team is not present at the time to bowl and a substitute is not readily available, the team must bowl on schedule with the number of bowlers present. Only the actual scores bowled will count. **NO BLIND** score shall be given.
2. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, her partner shall bowl the singles event first. If the entrant has not arrived by the time her partner has completed the singles event and a substitute is not available, the partner will be allowed to bowl the doubles event alone, in order to qualify for awards.
3. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee, nor shall she be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy she (the substitute) may win.

ATTIRE:

Bowlers should be suitably attired.

SCORES:

1. Tournament participants shall be responsible for checking their own scores.
2. Tournament officials shall make corrections to the telescopes, if deemed necessary, record the scores to the tournament tally sheets and verify tournament scores.

PRIZES:

1. In case of a tie for first place, co-champions shall be declared and duplicate awards given.
2. In case of a tie for team or individual score winners, prize money will be combined and divided equally between ties.
3. In case of a tie for individual trophy awards, a duplicate award will be made.
4. Prize money paid into each event will be returned to the winners in that event only. **Prize money will be paid with a ratio of 1 in 6 for Handicap and 1 in 10 for Scratch.** Prize money will be awarded in all four events in both handicap and scratch divisions, except that a team or individual qualifying in both divisions will receive only that prize which pays the higher amount.
5. Prize money will be distributed, to the team captain, **within thirty (30) days**, following the close of the tournament.
(TEAM CAPTAINS **MUST** DISTRIBUTE THE PRIZE MONEY WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS OF RECEIPT)
6. **Prize money checks will be void after 90 days from the date of being issued**
7. Awards will be presented at a time and place, within sixty (60) days following the close of the tournament. All award winners will be notified of the date and place.

THIS IS A USBC SANCTIONED TOURNAMENT. The Board of Directors of the Kingston USBC WBA shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.

The entrants whose names appear on the entry form or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the KUSBCWBA, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager before the tournament prize payments are made. An appeal or protest regarding the decision of the tournament manager or local association official in a sanctioned tournament may be made to USBC. The tournament management of local association official would be notified of such an appeal or protest.

KINGSTON USBC WBA ANNUAL TOURNAMENT TROPHY AWARDS

SCRATCH and HANDICAP (Scratch takes precedence over Handicap)

Trophy awards for Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events will be awarded as follows:

TEAM: A team award will be given to sponsor of the team bowling the highest score. A team entering with no sponsor shall receive four (4) individual awards, with the consent of the donor.

DOUBLES: Awards will be given to the partners bowling the highest six (6) game total in the doubles event.

ALL EVENT: An award will be given to the participant bowling the highest score for nine (9) games (3-team, 3-doubles and 3-singles). A bowlers first team participation will count for her All Events.

INDIVIDUAL

TRIPLE: An award will be given to the bowler bowling the highest triple, any event, unless she has qualified for the All Events Award, in which case her runner-up will be given the High Triple Award.

INDIVIDUAL

SINGLE: An award will be given to the bowler bowling the highest single game, any event, unless she has qualified for a higher award, in which case the award will be given to the runner-up, unless she in turn has qualified for a higher award, in such case the award will be given to the bowler in line who qualifies.

A bowler may take only one (1) of the above individual awards. If she qualifies for more than one, she must accept the highest award she qualifies for.

HIGHEST TRIPLE IN SINGLES EVENT:

- a. The Kingston USBC WBA Memorial Award will be given to the participant bowling the highest SCRATCH triple in the Singles Event.
- b. An award will be given to the participant bowling the highest triple with HANDICAP in the Singles Event.

These awards will be given to the bowler who qualifies, whether or not she has earned other individual awards.

SCRATCH AWARD:

a. MOST PINS OVER ENTERED AVERAGE - An award will be given to the participant bowling the most pins over her average for nine (9) games (3-team, 3-doubles and 3-singles). First team participation will count towards the nine game total.

This award will be given to the bowler who qualifies, whether or not she has earned any other award.

A special SCRATCH Award will be given if a Kingston USBC WBA Tournament record is broken.
